HANDS-ON HAYLOFT AT ANDERSON BARN HISTORY CENTER:



Come see where Bjorn stayed at Anderson Barn and experience a taste of old-time living. Follow Bjorn's hoof marks to our hayloft and play old-fashioned games, try on period clothing and play with our new puppet theater and barn animal puppets! Visitors may purchase a "Bjorn Buddy" button for \$8, which grants each child, and paying parent or guardian, unlimited access to our hayloft during our summer & fall season! The buttons are available for purchase at the Anderson Barn History Center or Anderson Store.

"ENCOUNTER WITH HISTORY":

Children between 7-12 years will have the opportunity to experience a decade in Ephraim's past by wearing period clothing, preparing food, doing chores and learning news, stories and lessons. The programs and related decades are:

1880s theme: "Making Fun on the Wisconsin Frontier" Wed., June 22, 11:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

1940s theme: "The War Years of WW II" Wed., August 3, 11:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

The cost is \$18 per child, per program. The program begins at the upper parking lot of Ephraim's Moravian Church, 9970 Moravia Street. Registration is limited to 14, so advanced registration is encouraged.
